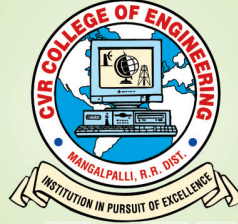

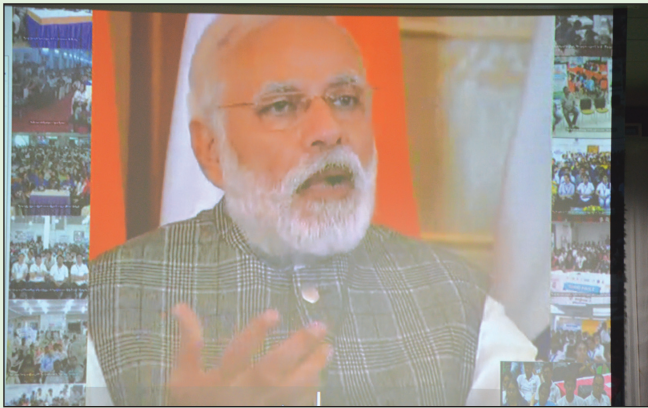

EDITORIAL MESSAGE

The most important events of this period were: 1. The College being chosen to conduct Hackathon'17, on 1 & 2 April; a one of its kind event conducted in recent times in India. 2. The college being ranked 100-150 at the National level, by the National Institute Ranking Framework under the Ministry of Human Resource Development. As has been the tradition at CVRCE, CIENCIA 2K17, the technical fest of the college was organized with great fervor on 30 March, 2017. The theme of the fest this year was "Being Human". The fest was promoted by a "Flash Mob", comprising of students of CVRCE. This group performed at landmark malls of the city, drawing attention to the impending fest in the college. The National level technical fest oversaw several events like Paper Presentations, Gaming, Short films, Photography Contests, Contests in Innovative Computer Programming etc. The print and the electronic media covered the event widely.

4 April witnessed the most awaited event of the college, "The Annual Day" preceded by the "Traditional Day". The college wore a festive look with students wearing colorful traditional dresses. The students put up a grand cultural event with foot tapping songs, humorous and thought provoking skits. Awards were presented to the meritorious students for their exemplary performance in academics and co curricular activities.

To refine existing skills and to build upon them, the college conducted a Staff Development Programme this year as well, from 5-17 June. 70 newly recruited faculty members participated in the program. The two week program saw guest lectures and workshops conducted by in house faculty members of the English department of CVRCE. The facilitators familiarized the participants with the new trends in training methodologies practiced in the real time work environments. This year the emphasis was on keeping the sessions interactive and learner friendly and so the FDP proved a fun place to learn.

The college celebrated Graduation Day on 24 & 25 June. This is an important event in the academic schedule of the college, conducted with great fanfare. Students and their performances are recognized and rewarded on this day. The college bid them a fond goodbye and launched them into higher endeavors of life, whether it is higher education or securing placements in reputed companies.

Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, invited institutions to apply for rankings under the title of **National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF)**. The college submitted an online application for the same. We are happy to inform all the stake holders, that **CVR College of Engineering has been ranked in the 101-150 rank group** and is **among the top 4 private colleges in Telangana**. In the list published by NIRF, CVRCE has been rated among the top 4 private engineering colleges in Telangana. (Only one other college from Telangana is in the top 100 and CVRCE along with two other colleges is in the 101-150 rank group).

CVR College of Engineering is rated among the top 25-35 private engineering colleges in the entire country. (Only 24 private engineering colleges are in the top 100 rank group).

Many congratulations!!! This achievement is thanks to the faculty, staff, students, employers, industry partners, alumni, affiliating university (JNTUH) and other stakeholders.

SMART INDIA HACKATHON '17 AT CVRCE

The Government of India hopes to bridge the digital divide in our country and further promote digital literacy in order to make development a comprehensive mass movement and put governance within everyone's reach in India. In order to work towards this vision, AICTE under aegis of MHRD and in collaboration with i4C, Persistent Systems Ltd., UGC, NASSCOM, Rambhau Prabhodini Mhalgi, SumaSoft Pvt. Ltd, Deloitte, ACM India, NIC, and MyGov proposed the Smart India Hackathon 2017; a unique computer programming competition to identify new and path breaking digital technology innovations was organized, for solving the challenges faced by our country. In this initiative, the aim was to institutionalize a model for harnessing the creativity and technical expertise of 3.0 + million students for direct benefit of our nation. Besides this, several union ministries agreed to be partners in this initiative.

Launched on 9 November, 2016 by Shri Prakash Javadekar, Hon'ble Minister for HRD in New Delhi, 'Smart India Hackathon 2017' harnessed creativity and expertise of the students, built a funnel for 'Startup India, Standup India' campaign, crowd sourced solutions for improving governance and quality of life, and provided an opportunity for the citizens to provide innovative solutions to India's daunting problems.

The Grand Finale of the 36 hours Contest was held on April 1& 2, 2017 at 26 nodal centers simultaneously. Winners stood to get cash prizes and a chance to be part of the NASSCOM's "10,000 Startups" program.

Highlights of the Hackathon

1. Smart India Hackathon 2017 was the first massive scale Hackathon initiative in India and unprecedented in the nation's history.
2. For the first time ever, 29 different government ministries and departments came together and posed 598 problem statements to 30 lakh technical students from India.
3. During Smart India Hackathon 2017, for the first time ever 10000+ technical students worked for 36 hours nonstop to build tools that the nation would benefit from. The digital solutions that were created, would improve the functioning and governance of different government departments. There is no better example of using our demographic dividend for the development of our nation. The idea was that students are a medium of change and if a large number of students come together, we would bridge the digital divide.

Some Quick Figures to Focus on

- 7531 entries were received from 2100+ Engineering/Technology colleges from across India.
- Each entry was submitted by group of 6 students which means there were 40,000+ students as participants.
- Maximum responses were received for problem statements from AICTE, Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Ministry of Railways, Ministry of Rural Development, Ministry of Tourism, and Ministry of Civil Aviation.
- Maximum entries were received from Tamil Nadu state, followed by Maharashtra.

- 300+ submissions were received under ‘Students’ Voice’ section that invited ideas for problem statements not proposed by any of the ministries.
- 17 [Facebook live talks](#) were held regarding Smart India Hackathon 2017.
- 26 workshops were held to encourage students in every corner of India.
- 11 massive Online Training Sessions (<https://www.mygov.in/home.talk>) on various topics were held, to train the participants to write the best codes at the Grand Finale.

Smart India Hackathon’ 17 was historic for CVR College of Engineering, Hyderabad as it was the first ever institute in Telangana to be one among the 26 nodal centers selected in India. The college hosted the mega event, where 41 teams with around 250 students along with their mentors, and 137 girls from various institutions across India participated to showcase their skills and developed technological methods for the welfare of specially abled people.

On 1 April, 2017, CVR College of Engineering held the Inaugural Ceremony of ‘Smart India Hackathon’ 17’ at 7 a.m. The Honorable Minister for Human Resource and Development, **Shri. Prakash Javadekar** inaugurated the world’s biggest digital movement through video conference, across all the nodal centers in India. **He emphasized on “New India-Digital India, New India-Start up India, New India- Make in India and New India-Innovative India”**, where every small innovation will make a difference in the lives of its people. He congratulated all the participants who took initiative to participate in the world’s biggest Hackathon. Shri. Javadekar appealed to the participants to take this Hackathon as an opportunity to make friends and form connections which would last throughout their lives as this was a festival of thoughts more than a competition.

The Honorable Prime Minister of India, Shri. Narendra Modi motivated and encouraged the participants at 10p.m

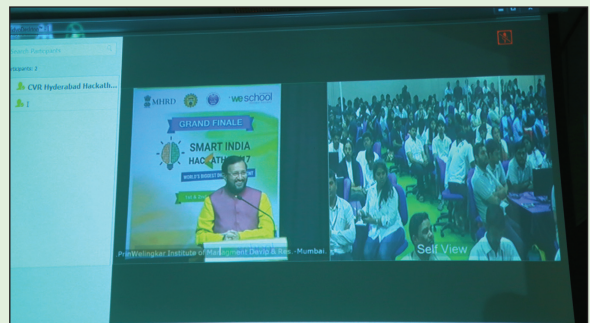

He shared his vision of “**New India**”, the youngest country in the world with 65% of youth population. His “My Gov” had identified 500 problem statements from various ministries across the nation and chose the **contribution of the youth in providing innovative solutions for Digital India**. He kindled the spirits of the youth to ignite the sense of New India amongst them. He shared his vision with the young i.e. to be a country in which the young

The Inaugural Function hosted by the college had domain experts, senior professionals from the IT industry and people from different ministries as judges for Hackathon’ 17. The Chief Guest of the function was, **Prof. A. Venugopal Reddy**, Vice Chancellor, JNTU-Hyderabad. **Mr. B. V. Ram Kumar**, Deputy Director, DEPWD, NIEPD, **Mr. Bala Murugan**, South Central Regional Officer, AICTE and **Mr. Yogesh Deshpande**, Practice Head, GS Lab, were also the part of this event.

The Chairman of the college **Dr. C. V. Raghava** briefed the participating students in the Hackathon, about the event being a beginning for providing solutions to the country’s challenges, towards building a better future. He told the students that they should take pride in being a part of the Grand Finale of this unique Hackathon. He also took pride in mentioning that CVR College of Engineering was the sole nodal center in the new state of Telangana. Dr. Raghava wished all the participants great success.

In his address, the Chief Guest, **Prof. A. Venugopal Reddy** stated that Smart India Hackathon’ 17 was a great event for the entire country. He complimented NASSCOM and AICTE who encouraged young minds to gear up to go for innovative applications. He congratulated CVR College of Engineering which imparts quality education and was hosting this grand event. He mentioned that this Hackathon was unique in its “massiveness and utility”.

The Principal of the college, **Dr. K. S. Nayanathara**, welcomed all the participants from various parts of the country, colleagues and students. She appreciated the active participation of the students and young talent who actively support the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities.

CIENCIA 2017

Ciencia, a National level technical symposium, organized by the CVR College of Engineering has over the years metamorphosed and diversified into a magniloquent phenomenon. Ciencia has played a salient role, and gained paramount importance and this ipso facto, has succeeded in catapulting CVRCE to levels of fame and technical excellence previously unheard of. Ciencia, has been one of the most innovative and the biggest technical fests in the state. This year it was organized with great enthusiasm and fanfare on 30 March, 2017. The Coordinator of Ciencia 2K17 was Dr. Venkateshwarlu, Head, Electrical and Electronics Department, CVRCE.

Ciencia-2K17 was based on the theme "**Digital India**". The Digital India programme is a flagship programme of the Government of India with a vision to transform India into a digitally empowered society and knowledge economy.

In order to promote this, for the first time the registrations were made digitally, which discarded the use of registration cards. Once the participant gave their details and registered themselves, a unique id was sent to the given mobile number. To bring about awareness on Digital India, students of CVRCE donned the role of social messengers by organizing a Flash Mob at Forum Sujana Mall, Hyderabad. This event successfully achieved its objective of promoting Ciencia as an event and also to create awareness about Digital India.

One of the major events of the fest was the Paper Presentations by students of all branches namely, Civil, CSE, Mechanical, IT, ECE, EEE, EIE. More than 300 papers were received from students of various engineering colleges and 75 among them, were selected for presentation. Prizes were awarded for top presentations, including a few from CVRCE. A one day workshop on "Ethical Hacking" and a

two day workshop on "Artificial Intelligence", were organized as a part of Ciencia-2K17. With more than 200 participants, the workshops proved to be huge success. A great number of Programming events, Analytical events, Electrical and Electronic events were conducted which tested the technical knowledge and thinking capabilities of students from various engineering colleges all over the country. Apart from the technical events, general events were also conducted.

Apart from these, a few special attractions like 4dfx, Vampire Estate, Gates of Hell proved to be crowd pullers this time.

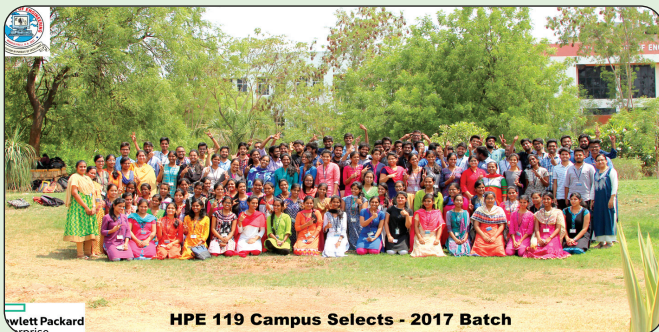
PLACEMENT ROUND UP
